Word from the President and the General Director

Once again this year, we have the privilege of presenting you with results that are both astonishing and appreciable, in a context where economic conditions (inflation and interest rates) are nevertheless pointing to an imminent slowdown. In fact, the results for the 2023-2024 financial year illustrate a sustained economic dynamism in the archipelago.

The corporation invested \$2,256,000 in loans to 32 businesses, helping to maintain or create 295 jobs, bringing the 10-year average investment to \$1,482,875 per year. Succession and start-up continue to play a major role, with the SADC supporting 10 business transfer projects and 9 start-up projects this year. The team is also active in the area of accompaniment. 117 companies have been accompanied in their efforts to meet a variety of needs relating to management, human resources, digital marketing, etc., while 14 have received support via the Soutien en entreprise and Virage vert programs. These interventions are important levers for propelling companies even further.

As for governance activities, the administrative board has adopted a Confidentiality Policy in compliance with Bill 25, introduced by the Quebec government. A culture of protecting personal and confidential information has long been established within the organization and is reflected in several concrete measures.

Additional important information to communicate to you: Although the agreement has not yet been signed, Canada Economic Development has indicated that it is renewing its confidence in the SADC des Îles for the next few years, as it has for the 66 other SADCs and Business Development Corporations (CAEs) in Quebec. This confidence is based on the quality of our work and results in the field, well documented by numerous performance indicators and more than ten independent studies by Statistics Canada.

Finally, the results presented in this report demonstrate the commitment of a dedicated team! Thank you to our employees, volunteers, mentors, and administrators, as well as to our entrepreneurs and partners, for their contribution to the economic vitality of the Magdalen Islands! Thank you to the team at Canada Economic Development, our main partner, as well as the Réseau des SADC et CAE for Quebec regions, both of whom provide invaluable support! We look forward to continuing our fruitful collaboration!


TOTAL INVESTMENTS 2023-2024



Evolution of investments over the last 5 years


INVESTMENTS GENERATED








Youth fund




